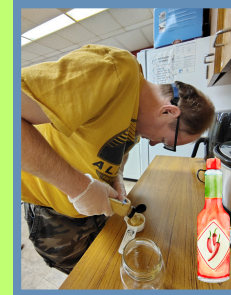
hello SUMMER

Individuals recently helped plant flowers to add beauty around the Center. We love seeing them take pride in helping make our space more enjoyable for everyone.



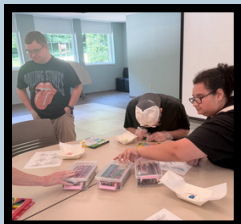
